Constituency names in Scotland since 1950

This paper describes the names used for parliamentary constituencies in Scotland since 1950, both for Westminster and for the Scottish Parliament. These constituencies resulted from our reviews.

We, in common with the other parliamentary Boundary Commissions in the United Kingdom, were established by the House of Commons (Redistribution of Seats) Act 1944. That legislation established the structure, procedures and rules for constituency design, which continue to the present, although there have been various amendments over the years.

The constituencies described in this Information Paper resulted from our Initial Report of 1947, our first six Periodical Reports on UK Parliament constituencies, submitted in 1954, 1969, 1983, 1994, 2004 and 2023.

We recommend names of constituencies as well as their boundaries. Our aim has been to recommend names that are relevant to the geographic extent of the constituency. Changes to names reflect external factors, such as changes to legislation, changes in local government structure and changes to the distribution of electorate.

Scottish local government underwent substantial reorganisation in 1975, with counties and burghs being replaced by regions, districts and islands areas. In 1983, in our first report after that reorganisation, we noted that constituencies had generally carried the name of the county or burgh which they were in, or of a large town in the constituency. We decided at that time to adopt names based on the names of the new local government areas rather than the preceding counties.

We completed the First Review of Scottish Parliament Boundaries in 2010 but responsibility for reviews of Scottish Parliament Boundaries transferred to Boundaries Scotland following the Scotland Act 2016. During the First Review of Scottish Parliament Boundaries we concluded that constituency names should reflect their geographic extents. We agreed that, wherever possible, constituency names should be short and should not attempt to describe an area exhaustively, and that names of Scottish Parliament constituencies should in general differ from those of UK Parliament constituencies. We also concluded that where a compass-point is used as part of a constituency name, it should not appear at the start of the name in order to ease the use of an alphabetical list of constituencies.

Each constituency is designated as either a county constituency or a burgh constituency. This designation affects the allowable expenses by candidates during elections.

Appendix A lists the names and designations of UK Parliament constituencies in Scotland since 1950, and the periods during which they existed.

Appendix B lists the names and designations of Scottish Parliament constituencies since the creation of the Scottish Parliament in 1999, and the periods during which they existed.

Appendix C is an index of the place names used in constituencies.
