UK Parliament constituencies in Scotland: 1997 - 2005

This paper explains the 72 UK Parliament constituencies in Scotland from 1997 to 2005, and their relationship with local government boundaries in Scotland.

These constituencies were implemented as recommended by our Fourth Periodical Report in December 1994 by the Parliamentary Constituencies (Scotland) Order 1995 (SI 1995/1037). They are made up of 28 burgh constituencies and 44 county constituencies.

These constituencies were contested in General Elections on 1 May 1997 and 7 June 2001, and in by-elections between 1997 and 2005. They were succeeded by the constituencies which we recommended in our Fifth Periodical Report, submitted in 2004.

These constituencies were also used for the modern Scottish Parliament from its establishment in 1999 until 2011, with one alteration which divided Orkney and Shetland into 2 constituencies.

Each constituency was designated as either a county constituency or a burgh constituency. These designations affect the allowable expenses by candidates during elections.

An alphabetical list of the constituencies and their designations is in Appendix A.

A list of which constituencies covered **each of Scotland's 32** unitary local government areas which were created in 1995 appears in Appendix B.

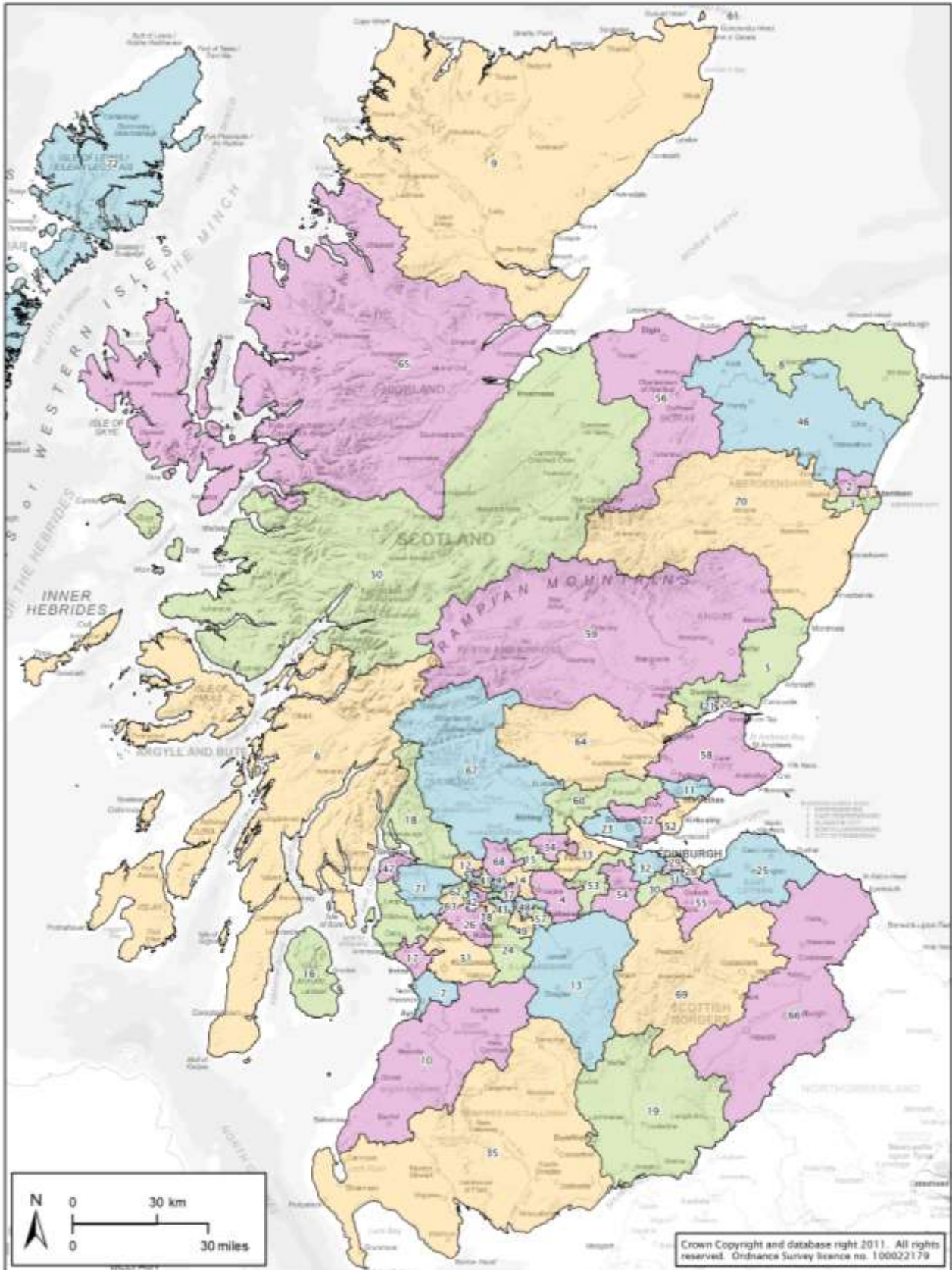
A list of the local government electoral wards which covered each constituency appears in Appendix C.

When these constituencies were originally designed, Scotland local government was a 2-tier system with region and district councils. The constituencies in each of those local authority areas are listed in Appendix D.

The electoral divisions within the regions and districts making up the constituencies when they were defined are listed in Appendix E.

Appendix C - Constituencies and wards

This Appendix lists the local government electoral wards which overlapped with each of the UK Parliament constituencies.

The wards are listed in 3 columns, depending on whether they were completely contained within a constituency ("Whole ward" column), or whether the largest part of the ward fell within a constituency ("Main part of ward" column), or whether a minor part of the ward fell within a constituency ("Minor part of ward" column). Each ward appears exactly once in either the "Whole ward" or "Main part of ward" column. In addition, any ward listed in the "Main part of ward" column also appears one or more times in the "Minor part of ward" column.

"Main part of ward" and "Minor part of ward" are determined by the number of postcodes within each part of the ward. The wards are those defined after the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland's Fourth Statutory Reviews of Electoral Arrangements, and which were first used for elections in 2007.

Appendix D - Constituencies and pre-1995 local authorities

This Appendix lists which UK Parliament constituencies covered **each of Scotland's** region, district and islands area local authorities, which existed between 1974 and 1995.

Under that local authority structure, most of Scotland comprised regions which were made up of a number of districts. The exceptions to this 2-tier structure of regions and districts were the islands areas of Orkney, Shetland and Western Isles which formed single tier local authorities.

Constituencies were each contained within a single region or islands area, with 3 exceptions:

- Tweeddale, Ettrick and Lauderdale constituency included parts of Borders region and Lothian region;
- Ochil constituency included parts of Central region and Tayside region;
- Orkney and Shetland constituency comprised Orkney and Shetland islands areas.

Appendix E - Constituencies and electoral divisions

This Appendix lists the local government electoral divisions which made up each UK Parliament constituencies.

Each region and islands area was divided into a number of electoral divisions for electoral purposes, with each electoral division being wholly contained in a single district. Each district was divided into a number of wards for electoral purposes, with each ward being wholly contained in a single electoral division.
