# 2018 Review of Westminster Constituencies Constituency names and designations

## Action required

1. The Commission is invited to agree the names and designations of the constituencies forming its Initial Proposals which are due for publication for public consultation on 20 October 2016.

### Background

- 2. The Commission has agreed most of the boundaries of the constituencies which will form its Initial Proposals in a series of papers at its meetings since June 2016. In those papers, a provisional name has been given to each constituency. The papers did not propose a county or burgh designation for constituencies. It is expected that the Commission will agree its final Initial Proposals at its September 2016 meeting.
- 3. The Commission has set out its policies on the naming and designation of constituencies in its Policies and Procedures booklet for the Review, which is reproduced at Appendix A.
- 4. This paper draws together the provisional names for all constituencies, suggests possible alternatives in some cases, and suggests a burgh or county designation for each constituency. That information appears at Appendix B.
- The Commission published an Information Paper in February 2011 listing and indexing past constituency names. 6. Appendix B lists for each council area the names of Initial Proposal constituencies as presented in papers considered at meetings, including those tabled for the September meeting, current UK Parliament constituencies and current Scottish Parliament constituencies. For each constituency an asterisk in the column headed "Pt" indicates that the constituency is only *partly* within that council area.

# Appendix A

# Extract from 2018 Review of Westminster Constituencies: Policies and Procedures

# Naming and designation of constituencies

- 1.1 As part of a review, we recommend a name for each constituency, and whether it should be designated as a county constituency or a burgh constituency. The designation affects the expenses allowable at elections.
  - 1.1.1 We have developed a set of guidelines when proposing names for constituencies:
  - to use an existing constituency name where there is a successor constituency that is recognisably similar;
  - to prefer constituency names that are short rather than attempt to describe an area exhaustively;
  - to ensure that names of Scottish Parliament constituencies in general differ from those of Westminster constituencies where an appropriate and distinct alternative is available. Relying on word order alone (e.g. "Glasgow East" and "East Glasgow") or conjunctions (e.g. "North and East Fife" and "North East Fife") is generally not a sufficient difference;
  - not to place compass points at the beginning of a name, in order to help make an alphabetically sorted list easier to use. We make an exception if a constituency is named after a council area or town which has a compass point at the start of its name (such as East Lothian or East Kilbride); and
  - not to use the same name for a constituency and a council area unless the two are coterminous.
  - 1.1.2 We take account of local views when recommending names for constituencies, and find suggestions from local authorities particularly useful.
  - 1.1.3 We are required to designate each constituency as either a burgh or a county constituency, but the legislation does not define these terms. We consider that constituencies comprising predominantly urban areas will normally be designated as burgh constituencies, and constituencies which are predominantly rural will normally be designated as county constituencies.
