Finance Update

For Information

- 1. A finance update table is at Appendix A. The Commission is invited to note its financial position as of 13 July 2020.
- 2. The budget shown is as set out in the draft Corporate Plan 2020-23, discussed at the 17 February 2020 meeting.
- 3. The Secretariat is awaiting clarification on the likely cost of using a shared consultation portal with the other UK Parliamentary Boundaries Commissions at the next Review. At the time of writing, the Secretariat is also awaiting a letter of delegation from the Office of the Secretary of State for Scotland. This is expected to be for c. £400,000.
- 4. The overall forecast has fallen by c £15,000. This is chiefly because the staff salaries forecast has fallen by £13,000 reflecting the increase in staff salaries, following the Scottish Government's pay settlement (and the net effect of tax / NI / pension changes), being less than forecast in the draft Corporate Plan.
- 5. The Accommodation forecast also falls by c £1,100 following the receipt of the estimated rent and associated charges for 2020-21 from the Commission's landlords, the Scottish Legal Aid Board.
