The Commission then undertook a 6-week secondary consultation on its initial proposals from 10 February 2022. During the two stages of consultation on its initial proposals from 10 February 2022. During the two stages of consultation on the Sinitial proposals the Commission received a total of 1,290 responses. Of those 1,290 responses, 11 MPs responded. When analysing all of the consultation responses and developing its revised proposals for consultation, the Commission made changes to the boundaries of constituencies where 9 MPs had commented on them.
