UK Parliament constituencies in Scotland: 1974 - 1983

This paper explains the 71 UK Parliament constituencies in Scotland from 1974 to 1983, and their relationship with local government boundaries in Scotland.

These constituencies were as recommended by our Second Periodical Report, submitted in 1969, and amended by our Interim Report submitted in 1972. They are made up of 29 burgh constituencies and 42 county constituencies.

The 46 constituencies which were created or amended as a result of the report were implemented by the Parliamentary Constituencies (Scotland) Order 1970 (SI 1970/1680). Nine of those constituency amendments only reflected changes to the boundaries of various burghs and districts which had taken place between 1960 and 1968. The remaining 25 constituencies continued as they had been defined after our earlier reviews.

Although the Second Periodical Report was submitted in 1969, its recommendations were not implemented until after the General Election of 1970, and therefore these constituencies were not used until the General Elections of 1974.

A summary of the main rules and their application during the Second Review were:

- Scotland shall have no less than 71 constituencies. Prior to 1974 there were 71 constituencies and 71 constituencies were recommended.
- every constituency should return a single member.
- all constituencies should be as near the electoral quota as practicable. The average electorate for the 71 Scottish constituencies was 47,745.
- the Commission may depart from the strict application of electoral parity if special geographical considerations apply. This rule was applied to retain the existing Western Isles constituency.

We reported in 1972 on an Interim Review after changes to the boundaries of several burghs and the cities of Aberdeen and Dundee, and recommended consequential amendments to 16 constituencies, indicated in Appendix A. Those changes were implemented by the Parliamentary Constituencies (Scotland) Orders 1973 (SI 1973/764 to 1973/770), and were used from the General Elections in 1974 onwards.

These constituencies were contested in General Elections on 28 February 1974, 10 October 1974 and 3 May 1979, and in by-elections between 1974 and 1983. These constituencies were succeeded by the constituencies which we recommended in our Third Periodical Report, submitted in 1983.

Each constituency is designated as either a county constituency or a burgh constituency. These designations affect the allowable expenses by candidates during elections.

In 1974, Scotland's local government was reorganised. Under the new structure, most of Scotland comprised regions which were made up of a number of districts. The exceptions to this 2-tier structure of regions and districts were the islands areas of Orkney, Shetland and Western Isles which formed single tier local authorities. This replaced the substantially different structure of counties and burghs which had existed before that date. Appendices B and C list the relationships between these constituencies and the counties and burghs which existed when they were designed.

Appendices D and E list the relationships between these constituencies and the regions, districts and islands areas.

Appendix A is an alphabetical list of the constituencies, their designations and dates of amendment.





Appendix A - Constituencies

This Appendix is an alphabetical list of the 29 burgh constituencies and 42 county constituencies. Some of the names of Edinburgh and Glasgow constituencies recommended in the report include a comma: these have been included in this alphabetical list for completeness, but omitted elsewhere for clarity. They were not included in the legislation implementing the review's recommendations.

The table also shows the date when each constituency was first implemented: 34 of the constituencies continued as they had existed before our Second Periodical Report. The table also shows the dates when each constituency was amended as a result of reviews following changes to burgh, district and city boundaries.

Appendix C - County composition of constituencies

This Appendix lists which counties and their constituent parts made up each UK Parliament constituencies. Most counties were made of burghs and districts, although a few small counties did not contain any districts. The city counties of Aberdeen, Dundee, Edinburgh and Glasgow were made up of wards.

The boundaries of the counties, burghs and wards are as they existed on 1 January 1969. The constituency definitions were amended in 1973 to reflect later amendments to the boundaries of several burghs and the cities of Aberdeen and Dundee.

Constituencies were made up of whole burghs, and generally whole districts and wards. Where only part of a district or ward was included in a constituency, this is indicated in the table.

Appendix E - Region composition of constituencies

This Appendix lists which region, district and islands areas (which existed between 1974 and 1995) covered each constituency. The constituencies were recommended on the basis of the counties which preceded the regions, districts and islands areas. However, the regions, districts and islands areas formed the local government structure of Scotland throughout the period of use of these constituencies.

Under that local authority structure, most of Scotland comprised regions which were made up of a number of districts. The exceptions to this 2-tier structure of regions and districts were the islands areas of Orkney, Shetland and Western Isles which formed single tier local authorities.
