UK PARLIAMENT CONSTITUENCIES IN SCOTLAND: 1983 - 1997

UK Parliament constituencies in Scotland: 1983 - 1997

This paper explains the 72 UK Parliament constituencies in Scotland from 1983 to 1997, and their relationship with local government boundaries in Scotland.

These 72 constituencies were implemented as recommended by our Third Periodical Report in 1983 by the Parliamentary Constituencies (Scotland) Order 1983 (SI 1983/422). They are made up of 29 burgh constituencies and 43 county constituencies.

A summary of the main rules and their application during the Third Review were:

- Scotland shall have no less than 71 constituencies. Prior to 1983 there were 71 constituencies. 72 constituencies were recommended. The increase in number of constituencies was due to the new rule – regard to local authority areas
- every constituency should return a single member.
- regard shall be had to the boundaries of local authority areas.
- all constituencies should be as near the electoral quota as practicable. The average electorate for the 71 Scottish constituencies was 53,649.
- the Commission may depart from the strict application of electoral parity if special geographical considerations apply. This rule was applied to constituencies within the Highland region and to retain the existing Orkney and Shetland and Western Isles constituencies.

Unlike in previous reviews, almost all of the recommended constituencies differed from their predecessors. This arose since the recommended constituencies took account of the local authority structure of regions, districts and islands areas which had existed in Scotland since 1974, and which replaced the substantially different structure of counties and burghs which had existed before that date. The only constituencies whose boundaries were unchanged by the review were in the islands, namely Orkney and Shetland constituency and Western Isles constituency.

We reported in 1986 on an Interim Review after local government boundary changes, and recommended consequential amendments to 14 constituencies, indicated in the table below. Those changes were implemented by the Parliamentary Constituencies (Scotland) Order 1987 (SI 1987/469).

We reported in 1988 and 1990 on Interim Reviews after local government boundary changes, which in combination recommended consequential amendments to 33 constituencies. Those changes were implemented by the Parliamentary Constituencies (Scotland) Orders 1988 (SI 1988/1992) and 1990 (SI 1990/2298) respectively.


These constituencies were contested in General Elections on 9 June 1983, 11 June 1987 (incorporating the 1987 amendments) and 9 April 1992 (incorporating the 1987, 1988 and 1990 amendments), and in by-elections between 1983 and 1997. These constituencies were succeeded by the constituencies which we recommended in our Fourth Periodical Report, submitted in 1994.

Each constituency is designated as either a county constituency or a burgh constituency. These designations affect the allowable expenses by candidates during elections.



Appendix A - Constituencies

This Appendix is an alphabetical list of the 29 burgh constituencies and 43 county constituencies. It includes for each constituency their designation, and whether they were amended as a result of reviews following local government changes. These amendments were implemented in 1987, 1988 and 1990.

Almost all of the recommended constituencies differed from their predecessors. The only constituencies whose boundaries were unchanged by the review were in the islands, namely Orkney and Shetland constituency (whose name was changed from Orkney and Zetland constituency) and Western Isles constituency.

Appendix B - Coverage of local government areas

This Appendix lists which constituencies covered each of Scotland's region, district and islands area local authorities, which existed between 1974 and 1995.

Under that local authority structure, most of Scotland comprised regions which were made up of a number of districts. Each region was divided into a number of electoral divisions for electoral purposes, with each electoral division being wholly contained in a single district. Each district was divided into a number of wards for electoral purposes, with each ward being wholly contained in a single electoral division.

The exceptions to this 2-tier structure of regions and districts were the islands areas of Orkney, Shetland and Western Isles which formed single tier local authorities.

Apart from Orkney and Shetland constituency, constituencies were each contained within a single region or islands area.

Appendix C - Constituencies and electoral divisions

This Appendix lists the local government electoral divisions which made up each constituency.

The exceptions were 8 electoral divisions which were each divided between 2 constituencies, using their constituent district wards: details are given in the table below. Electoral divisions and district wards are those defined in the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland's Initial Statutory Reviews, completed between 1978 and 1985.
